Eight individuals with disabilities moved into their newly built “Creative Living for Life” homes at a grand Ribbon Cutting Celebration on July 3, 2018. This was the start of their new life, fulfilling their dream of independent living. What a thrill for them, for their families and all in attendance who shared in their excitement and joy. With the purchase of the Weymouth Community Center, MCH is assuring that this building remains a community asset housing local non-profits and that the first schoolhouse for individuals with disabilities in the State of Ohio continues to serve the disabled population now and for many years to come. This building will continue to provide needed storage for donated items helping to reduce the cost of maintaining our homes. Additionally, the building will be rehabbed to allow for expansion of our programs, some of which currently have waiting lists.

The café will feature a true “farm to table” menu with hydroponically grown produce from Medina Creative Produce. - ◆ Build additional housing units in Wadsworth and Middleburg Heights which will allow us to take people off our waiting list and provide them with a home of their own, in the lifestyle they long for.
